

## How to Structure Your Bequest

You can leave a bequest to the Wildlife Rescue Center of Napa County with a simple statement in your will, in a codicil to your existing will, or in your revocable/living trust:

“I give and bequeath \_\_\_\_\_ to Wildlife Rescue Center Napa County, California, to be used for the general purposes of the organization.”

You may make a specific bequest:

“I give and bequeath to Wildlife Rescue Center Napa County, California, the sum of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ to be used for the general purposes of the organization.”

OR a residuary bequest:

“I give and bequeath to Wildlife Rescue Center Napa County, California, \_\_\_\_ percent of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate to be used for the general purposes of the organization.”

Wildlife Rescue Center of Napa County is recognized by the U.S. Internal Revenue Service and the State of California as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation; tax identification number #68 0271705.

When you include Wildlife Rescue Center Napa County, in your will, you become a member of the Shirley Harmon Circle, a group of thoughtful supporters who have done the same.
